## BG Flex Route: Monday - Friday, 7:00 AM - 4:45 PM & Saturday, 9 AM - 4:25 PM

*Excluding Major Holidays & Safe Seasonal Driving Conditions Permitted*

The BG Flex Route provides transportation to the general public in the Berlin-Gorham area. The bus can deviate up to 1/4 of a mile for curb side pick-up and drop-off, this courtesy requires prior notice. Please call 603-752-1741 to schedule a deviated pick-up or drop-off.

## Fares

- A day pass is \$3
- The more you ride, the more you save!
  - 7 day pass is \$18
  - 15 day pass is \$37
  - 30 day pass is \$72
- Day passes can be purchased on the bus or by visiting our office at 31 Pleasant Street Berlin, NH 03750.
- Exact fare fees are required, drivers do not carry change.
- For Medicaid recipients scheduling transportation for medical appointments, please contact your Medicaid broker first (their number is on the back of your Medicaid card). Medicaid brokers require 48 hours' notice for transportation requests.

## Facts & Rules

Tri-County Transit's mission is to provide safe, reliable transportation for all individuals. To ensure we meet our mission and keep our passengers safe, we have implemented the following protocols for our buses:

- No eating, drinking, smoking, solicitation, weapons, profanity, or disruptive behavior. Violators will be asked to leave the bus.
- Packages must be stowed and cannot block aisles, doorways, exits and may not occupy a seat.
- Service animals are permitted.
- Tri-County Transit busses are handicapped accessible.
- Riders aged 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult rider 18+.
- Riders with young children must supply their own car seat or booster seat.
